Toiletry Drive

Turn in your bag to the Student Services office from March 2nd to March 6th from 8:30-9:05 AM to receive your certificate.

Honor Roll FT to the Fair

The Honor Roll Field Trip to the Fair will take place Thursday, March 19th. Students will leave school no later than 9:15 and return by 1:00. All students must wear: Ammons Team t-shirt or school polo, midhigh length shorts or long pants and sneakers. Leggings, Sweatpants, Crocs or Slides are not allowed. For lunch, students had the option to request free cafeteria food on their field trip form. If not, students must bring their own lunch to school or have money to buy food at the venue. Students that are eating from the cafeteria or that bring their personal lunch, will eat when they return.

Report Cards and Interim Progress Reports

The third grading period will end on Thursday, April 2nd. Please check your child’s progress carefully, making note of the classes in which your child fell below a “C” (2.0). Students who fall below a 2.0 will be placed on Academic Probation and may be exited at the end of the school year. If you have any concerns, you should contact your child’s teacher.

Spring Break

Spring Break begins on March 23rd and ends March 27th. All students are due back to school on Monday, March 30th. Please do not extend your vacation beyond these dates. The FAST Writing Assessment dates are as follows: 6th grade is Tuesday, March 31st, 7th grade Wednesday, April 1st and 8th grade Thursday, April 2nd.

Service

All student service hours must be turned in to their Individual and Societies teacher by April 1st and April 2nd. Sixth graders must earn 10 hours, seventh graders 15 hours and eighth graders 20 hours. Service activities include a reflection form. Students must complete the service requirement to be eligible to receive the Ammons International Baccalaureate Middle Years Certificate in eighth grade. Parents, be sure to help your child meet this important deadline on April 1st and April 2nd.

IB Portfolio

All student portfolios are due to the Individual and Societies teachers by April 1st and April 2nd. Parents, be sure to help your child meet this important deadline. Community Project and Portfolio Mentoring will be held on Mondays during the month of March. Any student needing assistance with their portfolio may attend the IB Portfolio Clinic every Monday (March 2nd, 9th, and 16th) from 8:35–9:00 AM in room 1310. Students must stop by Room 1310 during homeroom to pick up their Portfolio Clinic Pass to attend.

End of the Year Fieldtrip Requirements

Students MUST have no lower than a C2B in all classes to remain eligible for all end of year trips. If students’ grades drop below the required minimum for the 3rd 9-weeks, he or she will be removed and **NO REFUNDS** will be available. In addition, any student receiving an administrative referral, administrative detention, or suspension after payment will not be permitted to participate in the activity – and will forfeit any money paid for the activity and/or field trip.
